

## INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR INTERIM REPORT 2010/11

### “Tournaments:

25/7-7/8/10: Ali Roy won British Girls u-15 Championships

4/9-12/9/10: Alan Tate and Jonathan Grant came equal 16<sup>th</sup> in The EU Individual Championships in Italy

19/9-4/10/10 : In the Olympiad in Russia, the open team finished 83<sup>rd</sup>, the women's team finished 65<sup>th</sup>

Joy Durno achieved the WFM title.

26/10-6/11/10 Craig Pritchett came 26<sup>th</sup> in World Seniors in Arco, Italy

13/11-20/11/10 Alan Tate came 3<sup>rd</sup> = and made a GM Norm in Mediterranean Open in Croatia

26/2/11-5/3/11 Capelle – Alan Tate made an IM Norm and came 60<sup>th</sup>, Neil Berry came 153<sup>rd</sup>

21/3/11-3/4/11 Alan Tate came 213<sup>th</sup> and Clement Sreeves 322<sup>nd</sup> in the European Individual, France

### Finances:

1. £5500 was allocated for the Olympiad in Russia. I would like the final amount which was paid to players with confirmation that no money has been refunded from FIDE.
2. For 2010/11 there was some underspend. It was suggested that Alan Tate should receive some of this to allay his entry fees and expenses. I would like confirmation what this underspend has been used for.
3. Craig Pritchett has suggested that entry fees should be paid when players or teams are representing Scotland in International tournaments. The estimated annual cost of this is £750. I would like confirmation how much funds will be available for this in 2011/12.
4. For 2011/12 I would like confirmation that £1500 will be available for the European Team Championships in November.
