GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZER

Vienna Chess Federation & Austrian Chess Federation under the auspices of the European Chess Union.

2. VENUE

Hotel AIRO Wien, Kurbadstrasse 8, 1100 Vienna, Austria.

4. SYSTEM AND RATE OF PLAY

The European Senior Team-Championship is an open tournament which will be played in 9 rounds Swiss System.

Time controls are 90 minutes for the first 40 moves followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one. Default time at the start of all rounds is 30 minutes.

5. PARTICIPATION

Entitled to participate are men who have reached the age of 60 years and women who have reached the age of 50 years, by December 31st, 2015.

Teams from every member federation of the European Chess Union can participate. The teams may represent a national federation or any regional structure of a national federation. All players of a team must be member of the same federation.

If women teams participate, a special ranking will be organized.

Each team shall consist of four players in fixed order. Additionally one reserve player can be nominated who is only allowed to play on board 4.

A provisional nomination of the players and the reserve player has to be submitted together with the registration of the team. Changes in the team can be made until the captains meeting takes place. The start ranking list will be determined by the average rating (board 1-4) of every team.

6. AWARDS, TITLES & PRIZES

Prizes:

1 st place	1.200€ +	gold medals	4 th place	500€

The team with the best improvement to the start ranking list obtains a special prize in the amount of 400 \in .

Prizes for women teams:

1 st place	500€ +	gold medals
2 nd place	300€ +	silver medals
3 rd place	200€ +	bronze medals

Material prizes for all participating players.

The winner of the European Senior Team-Championship will be awarded the title "European Senior Team-Champion 2015".

The best women team of the European Senior Team-Championship will be awarded the title "European Senior Women-Team-Champion 2015".

7. RANKING

The ranking will be determined by the number of match points (win = 2 match points, draw = 1 match point, loss = 0 match points).

Tie-Break:

- a) match points of each opponent (cut 1) x game points scored against him
- b) game points
- c) sum of game points of all opponents
- d) sum of game points of all opponents defeated plus one half of the game points of all the opponents with which a tied result was achieved

Board prizes are awarded for the best performance rating of players (having at least played 7 games). In case of a tie it will be broken by (a) direct encounter, (b) higher number of games, (c) percentage score and (d) team rank.

8. ENTRY FEE

In accordance with the ECU regulations each team is obliged to pay the entry fee of $100 \in$ per team before the competition starts directly to the account of the European Chess Union.

9. REGISTRATION FEE

The registration fee per player will be $40 \in$ for nominations by March 31^{st} 2015. That means a maximum of 200 \in per team.

For later applications the registration fee will be 60 \in per player. This means a maximum of 300 \in per team.

Registrations come into effect only after confirmation by the tournament director.

10. ACCOMMODATION

Playing venue and accommodation will be in the **Hotel AIRO Wien** which has the optimal location and surroundings for this event.

The Vienna International Airport can be reached in 15 minutes by car and the motorway is a few-minute drive away. Free private parking is available for all participants. The distance to the city centre is 9 km and by public traffic you need about 25 minutes.

30% of total accommodation costs must be transferred as deposit after the confirmed registration.

At lunchtime snacks (3 - 9 \in) will be offered in the playing area. The restaurant Rotisserie serves Austrian and international cuisine and business dinner buffet is available for 18 \in /person/evening.
