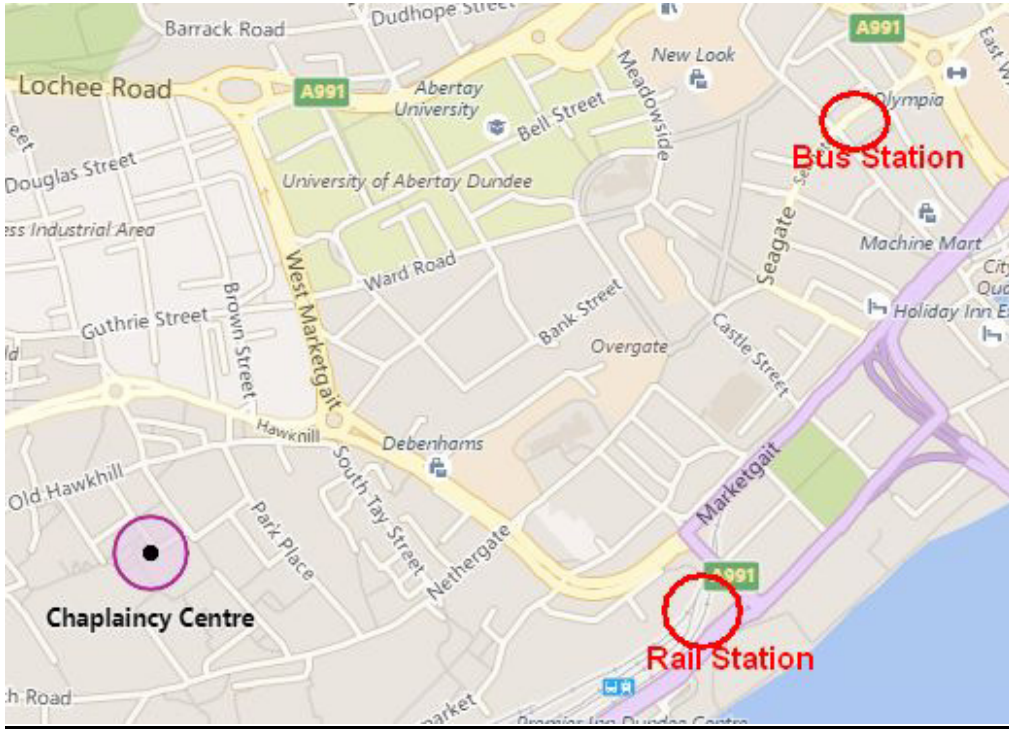


Venue
