Sadly, there are few factories left in Stewarton making bonnets but the Guild continues, supporting community events and running the Bonnet Guild Festival gala week in June each year.*

### Discount for juniors

We are offering a free entry for a junior player (aged under 16 on the day) who enters with any two adult players from the same club.

### New and returning adult players

For any adult player bringing a new adult player to the event or bringing a returning adult player (someone who hasn't played in Stewarton Allegro since 2012) – we will offer £6 off their combined entry fees – they can split the discount, or one can have reduced entry.

Only one discount allowed per application and all discounts only apply to entries received by the closing date.

### Behaviour of players

The organisers will not be responsible for the behaviour of players - especially juniors during this event. Clubs and parents should ensure that juniors have responsible adult supervision at this event.

### Photography

Please note that the organisers of this event may take photos for publicity and marketing purposes and attendance as a player or spectator at this event gives permission for such photos to be taken.

### Grading

This year we will be using Chess Scotland grades in following sequence

1. CS live Allegro grade if player has one
2. CS live Normal grade if player doesn't have an Allegro grade
3. CS Normal grade at start of the season
4. If none of above, then an Estimated grade may be used

All results from this event will be submitted to Chess Scotland for Allegro grading.

### Events

1. Open Open to all entrants
2. Major Open to entrants with a grade of 1750 or less
3. Minor Open to entrants with a grade of 1450 or less – see above
4. Under 14 Open to juniors aged under 14 on the day and if graded, a grade of 1100 or less – see above
5. Under 12 Open to juniors aged under 12 on the day and if graded, a grade of 900 or less – see above.

### Round Timings as follows (Approximate)

Round 1	-	10.30am - 11.30am
Round 2	-	11.55am – 12.55pm
Lunch break	-	12.55pm to 1.35pm
Round 3	-	1.35pm - 2.35pm
Round 4	-	3pm - 4pm
Round 5	-	4.30pm - 5.30pm

We hope you will stay for the Prizegiving which will take place as soon as possible after the tournament is finished. This should be at approximately 5.45pm.

This event will be held as a five round Allegro event played using the 2018 FIDE Laws of Chess Appendix A.4 on Rapid games. Each player has 30 minutes for their moves in each round. The tournament will be run as a Swiss event - this means that everyone plays five games (it is NOT a knockout). Guideline III.4 of Guideline III will apply to all games

### ENTRY FEES

Events 1,2 and 3	Adults	£14.00
	Juniors (under 16 on the day)	£9.00
Events 4 and 5	All juniors	£7.00

There will be a discount available for members of the same family playing in any section of the tournament. Each member of the family may deduct 50p from their entry fee. (Please note family members are classed as brothers or sisters or fathers or mothers or grandparents)

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without explanation and to make any adjustments necessary to ensure the smooth running of the tournament.

### PRIZES

All the sections in our tournament will include our usual prizes of First, Second and Third. We will aim to have a selection of other prizes such as Grading, Age, Best Ayrshire, Best local and our popular Family prizes.

1. Open First £100, Second £50, Third £30 plus trophy/medals  
Best player overall: The Bonnet Guild Trophy
2. Major First £75, Second £45, Third £30 plus trophy/medals
3. Minor First £75, Second £45, Third £30 plus trophy/medals
4. Under 14 First £30, Second £20, Third £15 plus trophy/medals
5. Under 12 First £30, Second £20, Third £15 plus trophy/medals

All prizes quoted above are dependent on a sufficient number of entrants and may be adjusted at the discretion of the organisers. Other prizes such as grading and age prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organisers.

The cost of postage stamps has risen considerably over the past few years and we would encourage players to supply their email addresses to us in order that we can send you the entry forms by email and so reduce our costs in future years. We will continue to post out entry forms to players who would like a paper copy and would like to thank you for your consideration.
