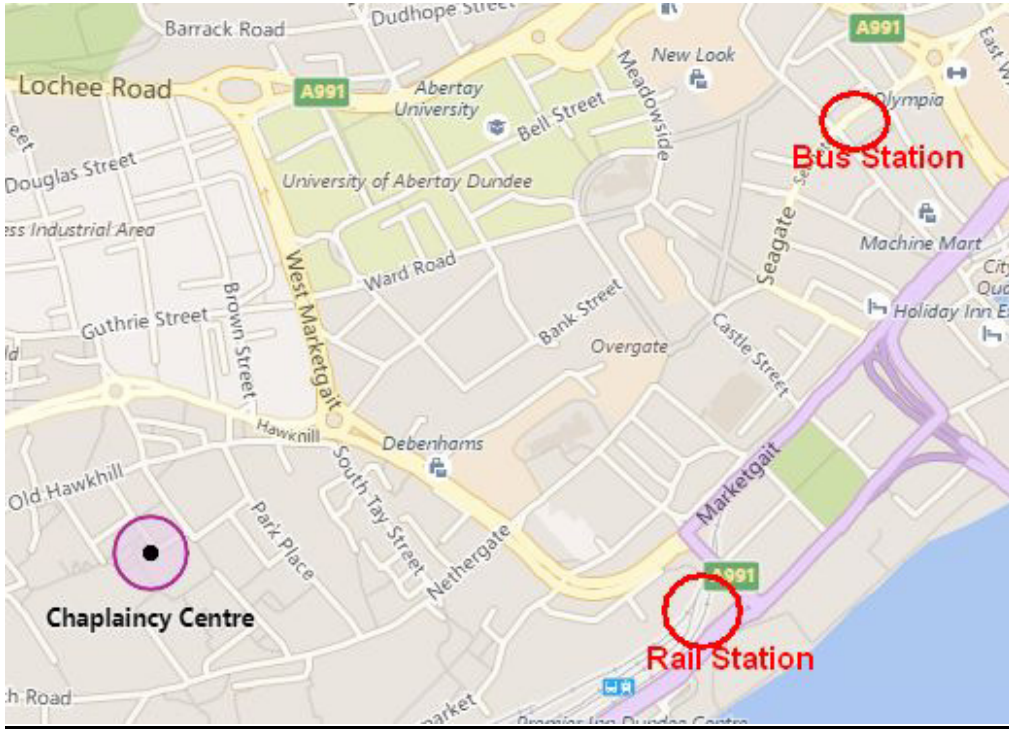


Venue
