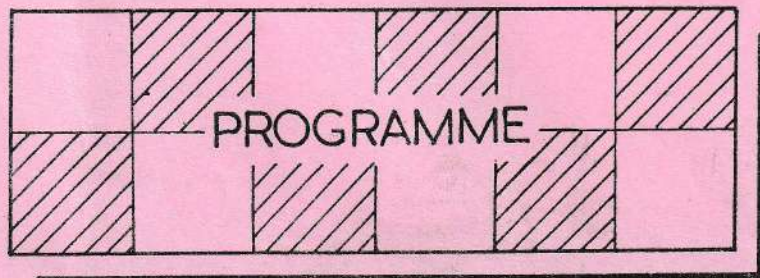
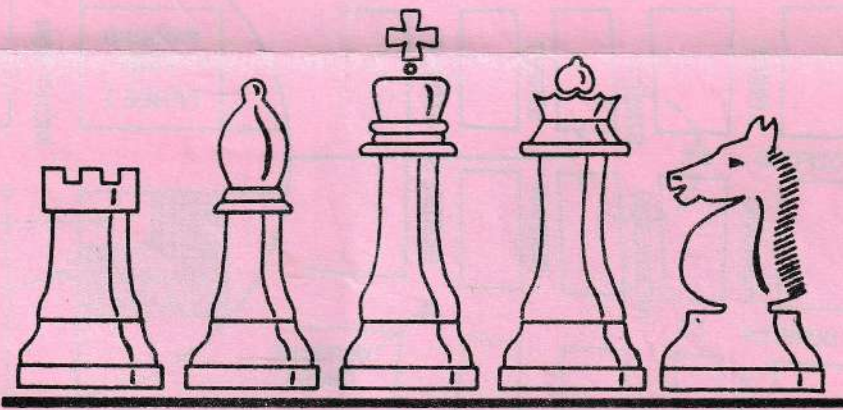
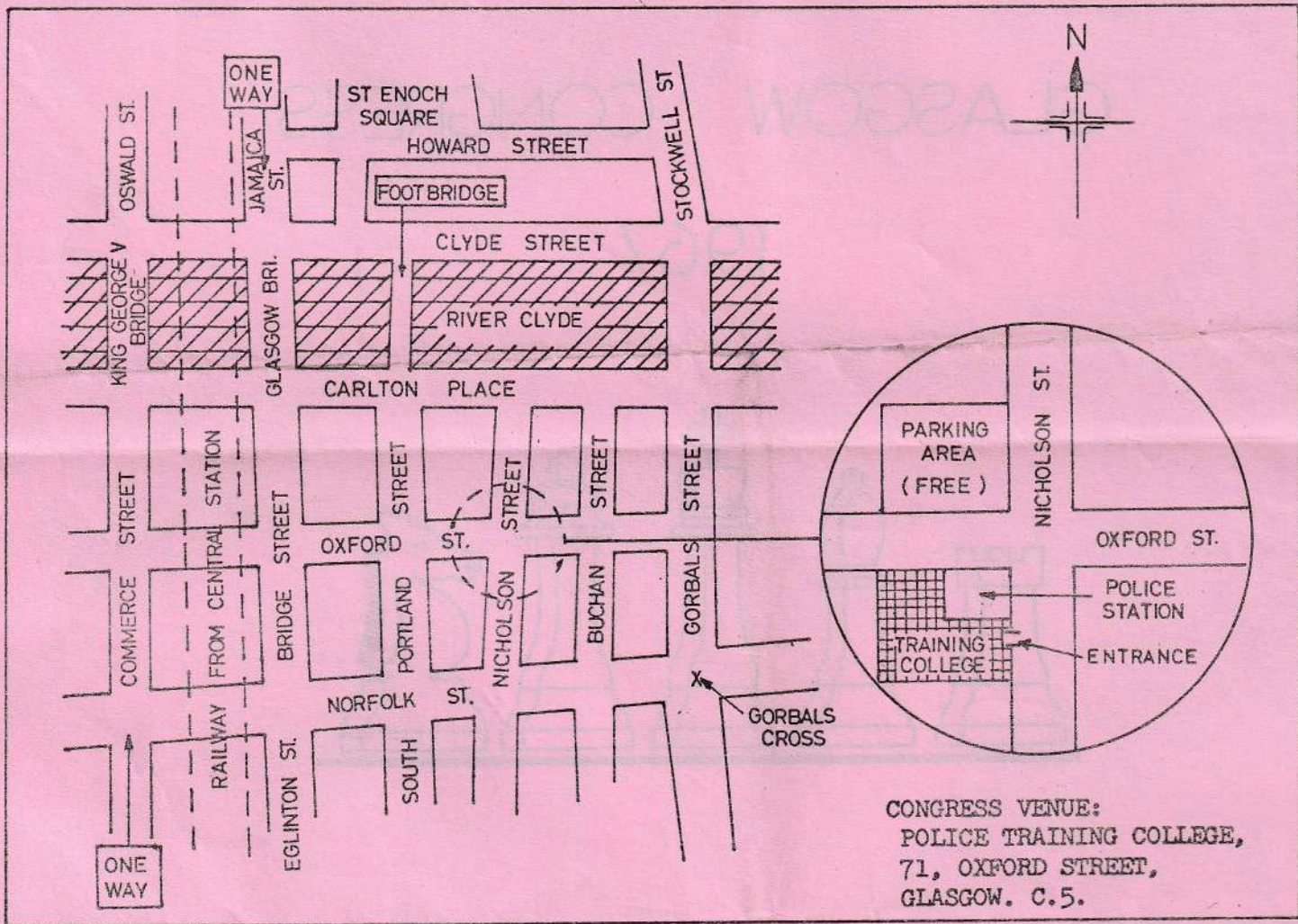

### OPENING CEREMONY

The Congress will be officially opened in the principal hall on Saturday, 23rd September, 1967, at 10.30a.m. by Baillie William M. Hutcheson, Senior Magistrate of City of Glasgow. All play shall be stopped for this purpose.

### CATERING:

A limited number of lunches will be available from 12.30p.m. until 2.30p.m. each day. Reservation tickets may be obtained from Congress officials.

Tea, biscuits, etc., will be on sale in the Canteen from 10.00a.m. to 12 noon, and 3.00p.m. to 5.00p.m. each day.

### BOOKSTALL:

Mr. B.H. Wood, Editor of "CHESS" will be running the bookstall.

### PRIZE FOR BEST JUNIOR GAME:

The President of the Glasgow Chess League will give a prize for the best junior game played during the Congress.

Players wishing to be considered for this prize should deliver to the Recorder, before 6.00p.m. on Monday 25th September, 1967, a record showing :-

(i) game score, (ii) opponent's name, (iii) tournament and round number.

### SPECTATORS:

The Organising Committee invite non-participants to visit the Congress during the playing sessions and prize-giving ceremony.

### CLOSING CEREMONY

The closing ceremony will take place in the principal hall at 8.00p.m. on Monday 25th September, 1967. Mr. Gair Henderson, the well-known Sports Writer and Sports Editor of the "Evening Times" will present the prizes.

## CONGRESS RULES

1. All games shall be played in the tournament rooms at the following times:-
  - (a) Glasgow Open and Reserve Championship:  
Main Sessions: 9.00a.m. to 1.00p.m. and 3.00p.m. to 7.00p.m. each day.  
Adjournment Sessions: Commence 8.30p.m. each evening.
  - (b) Other Tournaments (except Junior Championship):  
Main Sessions: 9.30a.m. to 12.30p.m. and 2.30p.m. to 5.30p.m. each day.  
Adjournment Sessions: Commence 7.00p.m. each day.
  - (c) Junior Championship: 9.30a.m. to 12.30p.m., 2.30p.m. to 4.15p.m., and 4.30p.m. to 6.15p.m. each day.
2. The rate of play shall be as follows:-
  - (a) Glasgow Open and Reserve Championship:  
Not less than 45 moves in the first 2 hours and 20 moves per hour thereafter.
  - (b) Other Tournaments:  
Not less than 40 moves in the first 1½ hours and 20 moves per hour thereafter.
3. Any competitor who is not present within one hour after the time fixed for the commencement of a main session or for the resumption of an adjourned game will forfeit that game.
4. When a game is completed the following procedure is to be followed:-
  - (i) Re-set the board.
  - (ii) The winner of the game shall deliver to the Recorder a signed record of the moves made in the game. In the case of drawn games a record signed by both players shall be delivered to the Recorder.
5. If a game is unfinished at the end of a session and, provided the conditions of Rule 2 have been fulfilled, the next move of the player shall be sealed.
6. Competitors desiring to analyse their games must do so in the room provided for this purpose and not in any of the tournament rooms.

## SUPPLEMENTARY RULES

1. Do not play 5 minute chess with the clocks. Such mis-use would be unfair to the owners of the clocks.
2. Since the Congress is being housed in police premises certain security arrangements have to be adhered to. Please co-operate by keeping to the rooms, toilets, cloakrooms, corridors, etc., which have been allocated to us.
3. Smoking is permitted in all areas allocated to us but please use ash trays provided.
4. Shoes likely to cause damage to the tiled floors must not be worn.
