

- SEVENTH GLASGOW CHESS CONGRESS -

Many of you will have read in the Congress Programme that new records are set up more or less annually by the Congress and this year is no exception. 242 competitors are taking part in the Congress this weekend, thus setting a new Scottish record for the number of competitors at a tournament.

Facilities and playing conditions in the Langside Hall have never been surpassed at any Scottish Congress but this is not surprising when one considers the composition of the Congress Committee, Scottish Internationals G. Bonner and H.D. Holmes, W. Munn, E. Fitzjames, S. Mannion and J. Pursley, all of whom have made tremendous efforts to make the Congress the success it is.

This is how H.D. Holmes, Controller of the Invitation Event, describes this year's top tournament:

This year your Committee has decided to organise the principal event as an Invitation Tournament of 16 players. We have been extremely fortunate to have seven Internationals participating (four Scottish, two English and one Irish).

The player who takes even the slightest interest in Chess played outside his own Club must surely have heard of Mr. Golombek: an International Master, a former English Captain, the Chess Correspondent of "The Times", an eminent author (his books include "Capablanca's 100 Best Games" and "Modern Opening Strategy"), an arbiter of international repute (he refereed Botvinnik-Smyslov matches for the World Championship) and a Chess "Politician" (he is a member of F.I.D.E.'s Executive Committee). Next month he will be assisting the Swiss Chess Federation to run the Chess Olympiad in Lugano.

Michael Basman belongs to the present young school of English Players. He impressed Botvinnik with his prowess a couple of years ago and this year finished second in the British Championship.

Michael Littleton has also booked his ticket to Lugano - but he will be travelling with the Irish Team. He is currently rated No. 2 (behind W. Heidenfeld) and has two Irish Championship victories to his credit.

David Levy is an Englishman but is now living in Glasgow. He had the temerity to win this year's Scottish Championship at Ayr and has been selected to go to Lugano.

Ken McAlpine first played his way into the Chess headlines by beating Mr. Fairhurst in a game in the Scottish Championship while still at school. That year he was the runner-up - a performance which he was to repeat the following year. He was board 3 for Scotland in the Havana Olympiad.

Craig Pritchett finished seventh in this year's British Championship - a fine result for his first attempt. He also was a member of the last Scottish Olympic Party and his consistant play ensured the team a respectable score in the final section.
