THE GLASGOW CHESS CONGRESS 1973.

The 1972 Congress had 345 competitors and until this year's event held the Scottish Record. This year the entries were broken down as follows :-

This is the new Scottish Record.

The main innovation to the 1973 Congress was an International Invitation Tournament and this attracted several very strong players including R HUBNER one of the World's strongest grandmasters. H.Ree from Holland; O M Hindle, and M F Stean made up a rather weaker English contingent than was expected; H Williams from Wales; and B Kernan from Ireland; made up the non-Scottish players. Only C Pritchett of the leading Scottish players was missing from a stronger-than-usual 'home' select.

R Hubner was rarely troubled and won convincingly from H Ree. In 3rd place R McKay of the Cathcart Chess Club played well and gave the spectators their money's worth. Scottish Champion P Jamieson played well below par. Neither International Master D Levy nor H Williams produced their best play.

The competition was well-organised by the controller E Fitzjames and both foreign competitors have asked to return some time in the future.
