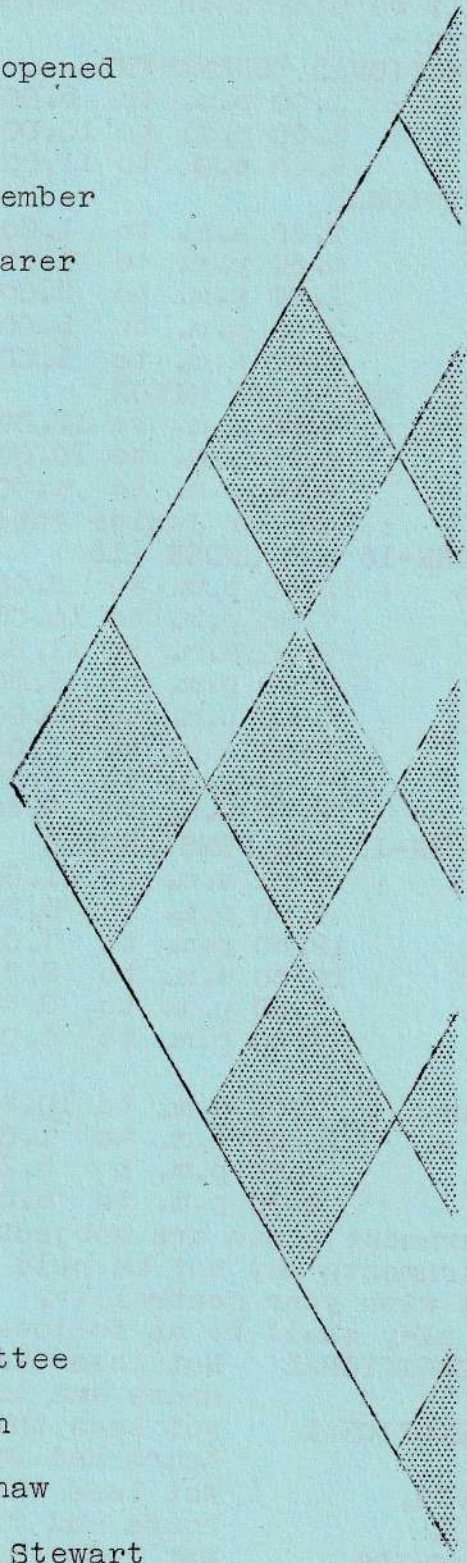

2. The rate of play shall be as follows:-

GLASGOW INTERNATIONAL Not less than 40 moves in the first  $2\frac{1}{2}$  hours and 16 moves per hour thereafter.

JUNIOR INTERNATIONAL Not less than 40 moves in the first 2 hours and 20 moves per hour thereafter.

OPEN, RESERVES, MAJOR & MINOR Not less than 40 moves in the first  $1\frac{3}{4}$  hours and 2 moves per hour thereafter.

OTHER TOURNAMENTS Not less than 36 moves in the first  $1\frac{1}{4}$  hours and 20 moves per hour thereafter.

2. Games started in Junior Events without clocks.  
The Controllers reserve the right to introduce clocks at which time each player will be given a minimum of 15 minutes to complete the game.
  3. Any competitor who is not present within one hour after the time fixed for the commencement of a Main Session or for the resumption of an adjourned game will forfeit that game.
  4. When a game is completed the following procedure is to be followed.
    - A. Reset the board.
    - B. The winner of the game shall report the result to the Controller, if the game is drawn the player with the white pieces shall report. In the Glasgow International, Junior International and Open Tournaments the player reporting the result must also hand in a record of the moves made in the game signed by both players.
- Note: Until this rule has been complied with, the result shall NOT be officially recorded.
5. If a game is unfinished at the end of a session and, provided the conditions of rule 2 have been fulfilled, the next move in the game shall be sealed.
  6. Competitors desiring to discuss and analyse their games must do so in the rooms provided for this purpose and NOT in any of the tournament rooms.
  7. During playing sessions complete silence must be maintained by all competitors. Players contravening this rule may be penalised by the loss of their current games.

#### SUPPLEMENTARY RULES

1. Do not play 5-minute chess with the clocks. Such mis-use would be unfair to the owners of the clocks.
2. Competitors are asked not to enter the tournament rooms during the intervals between playing sessions.
3. Smoking is permitted in all areas BUT please use ashtrays provided.
4. While the Glasgow International Tournament is in progress only Friends and Supporters will be allowed in the Tournament Hall otherwise spectating will be confined to the balcony.

**BOOKSTALL** : Chess books, magazines and equipment will be on sale in the bookstall.

**BEST GAME** : A prize for the best game played by a Junior during the congress will be given by the President of the Glasgow Chess League. Players wishing to be considered for this prize should deliver their game to the CONTROL TABLE before 6.30 p.m. on Monday 30th September. They must show:  
(a) an intelligible record of the moves made, and,  
(b) the tournament and round number.

**GIRLS' CHAMPIONSHIP** : Tenure of the Glasgow Girls' Championship Trophy for one year to the highest placed Glasgow Girl in the under 16 championship.

**TOURNAMENT BULLETIN** : This will be produced just after the Congress and will contain all the games played in the Glasgow International Tournament and a selection from the other principal events. ### HOW TO REACH THE CONGRESS:

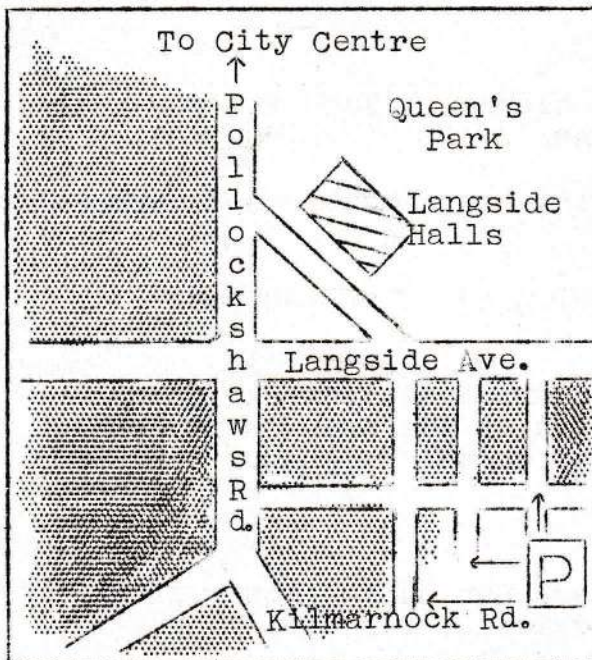
Langside Hall is located at the south west corner of Queen's Park not very far from the city centre.
