1. All games shall be played in the Tournament Rooms and the hours of play shall be as follows:

NOTE

Adjournment times are subject to alteration and may not be held in the same room as the main session. Please check with your controller.

2. The rates of play shall be as follows:

JUNIOR INTERNATIONAL,
OPEN & MAJOR Not less than 40 moves in the first 2 hours, not less than 20 moves in the next hour and 10 moves per $\frac{1}{2}$ hour thereafter.

OTHER TOURNAMENTS Not less than 36 moves in the first $1\frac{1}{4}$ hours and 20 moves per hour thereafter.

3. Games started in Junior events without clocks.

The controller reserves the right to introduce clocks at which time each player will be given 15 minutes to complete the game.

4. Any competitor who is not present within 1 hour after the time fixed for the commencement of a Main Session or for the resumption of an adjourned game, will forfeit that game.

5. When a game is completed, the following procedure is to be adopted:
 - A. Reset the board.
 - B. The winner shall report the result to the controller.
If the game is drawn, the player with the white pieces shall report.
In the JUNIOR INTERNATIONAL, OPEN, MAJOR & PRESIDENT'S tournaments the results should be reported on the slips provided and, in the JUNIOR INTERNATIONAL & OPEN tournaments the player reporting the result must also hand in a record of the moves signed by both players.

NOTE: Until this rule has been complied with, the result will not be officially recorded.
6. If a game is unfinished at the end of a Session and, provided the conditions of Rule 2 have been fulfilled, the next move shall be sealed. Results of adjourned games must be reported immediately, by telephone if necessary.
7. Competitors desiring to analyse their games must do so in the rooms provided for this purpose and NOT in any of the Tournament Rooms.
8. During playing Sessions, complete silence must be maintained by all competitors. Subject to the controller's discretion, each infringement of this rule will incur a penalty of one $\frac{1}{2}$ point to be deducted from the competitor's final score.
9. Instances of misconduct by competitors will result in penalties ranging from deduction of points to expulsion from the Congress.
10. Any competitor withdrawing from a tournament will be barred from the 1980 Congress unless adequate reason for withdrawal is given to the Congress Committee.
11. In all matters concerning the interpretation of these rules, the Chief Controller's decision will be final.

SUPPLEMENTARY RULES

- a) Do not play 5-minute chess with the clocks. Such mis-use would be unfair to the owners of the clocks.
- b) Competitors are asked not to enter the Tournament Rooms during the intervals between playing sessions.
- c) Smoking is permitted but PLEASE use the ashtrays provided

GENERAL NOTICES

- CATERING: Visit the Congress Snack-Bar on the lower floor for tea, coffee, soup, sandwiches, biscuits and sweets.
- BOOKSTALL: Chess books, magazines and equipment will be on sale.
- GLASGOW CUP: This trophy is presented to the highest placed Glasgow player in the OPEN tournament. Ties will be resolved by 'Sum of opponent's Scores' Method.
- GIRLS' CHAMPIONSHIP: Tenure of the Glasgow Girls Championship Trophy for 1 year to the highest placed Glasgow girl in the U-17 Championship.
- BEST GAME: A prize for the best game during the Congress in a Junior Event (excluding the International) will be given by the President of the Glasgow Chess League. Players wishing to be considered for this prize should deliver their game to their

Controller before 6.30pm on Monday 24th September. They must show:

- (i) an intelligible record of the moves made and,
- (ii) the tournament round number.

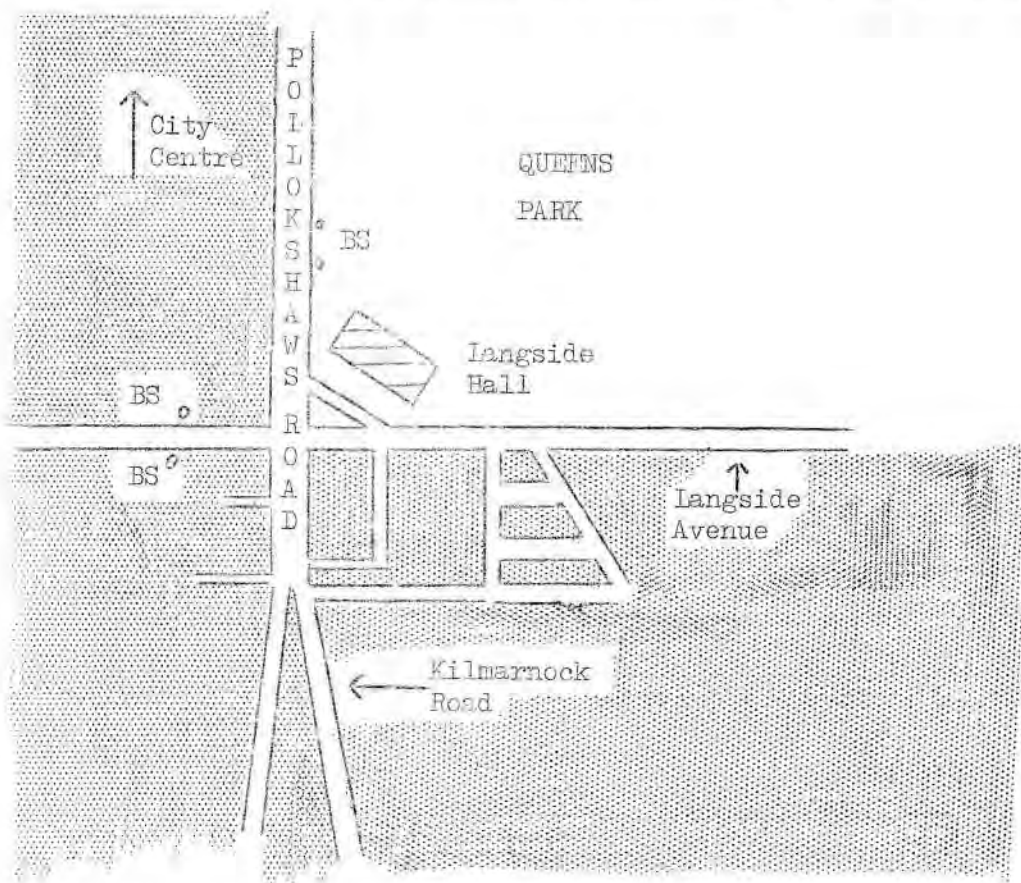
HOW TO REACH THE CONGRESS

Langside Hall is located at the South-West corner of Queens Park, not very far from the City Centre. The following buses stop in Pollokshaws Road, near the Hall entrance.

From Renfield Street: 23, 38, 38A, 45, 48, 48A -Fare 30p

From Midland Street: 21, 21A - Fare 25p

In addition, services 89 and 90 stop in Langside Avenue.
Service no. 34 (Govan Cross/Castlemilk) stops in Langside Road.



PARKING

A limited amount of parking space is available within the Hall grounds but do not double-park. Cars may park in Baker Street, Deanston Drive and Tantallon Road, off Langside Avenue, opposite the Hall.

Parking is not permitted in Langside Avenue nor in Pollokshaws Road which is the main road to Kilmarnock, Ayr and South-West Scotland.
