

The working party looking at revision of the CS constitution (CWP) has now been formed (for names of members see <http://www.chessscotland.com/news/?p=3153> ).

Ideas and suggestions would be welcomed in written form from any CS member.

Comments can either be placed on the 'Your Views' section of the CS Website in the section 'Discussion of Constitution Amendments' for public view or sent to any individual member of the CWP who will then forward the email to all other members of the CWP.

To ensure all thoughts of members are transmitted accurately only written comments will be considered, verbal statements or discussions will not. For the same reason, members of the CWP will not enter into any private discussion on issues that relate to the constitution nor the membership or operation of the CWP. Members of the CWP will also not enter into any discussions on the Notice Board. It would also help if comments be numbered as in the current Constitution (which can be accessed at <http://chessscotland.com/csinfo/csconstit.htm>). Currently there are 16 main sections, but 'Eligibility' will also be considered by the CWP (for convenience this will be termed Section 17 at present).

Comments would be expected by Friday 14th February. The final recommendations from the CWP will be presented to either the AGM or an SGM for ratification or amendment by the CS membership.
